

Regulations regarding Adult Prices

- Unfortunately, Federal regulations dictate the price that we should charge for adult meals.
- USDA regulations specify that in no way should the federal program subsidize the meals provided to adults. This means that the charge for visitor or adult meal must cover all cost of the meal.
- The following formula is to be used to determine the adult lunch prices in a district:
 - The price of the highest paid meal to students (\$3.00) plus the Federal Reimbursement for paid meals (.39 cents) plus the value of commodities received(.34 cents) for a total of **\$3.73.**
 - OR
 - The Federal Reimbursement for free students (\$3.31) plus the value of commodities received (.34 cents) for a total of **\$3.65.**
- The following formula is to be used to determine the adult breakfast prices in a district:
 - The price of the highest paid meal to students (\$2.00) plus the Federal Reimbursement for paid meals (.30 cents) for a total of **\$2.30**
 - OR
 - The Federal Reimbursement for free students **\$2.09.**
- **Adult prices will be \$3.75 for lunch and \$2.50 for breakfast for the 2017-18 school year.**
